- <u>Approval of February Minutes</u> Lori motioned to approve minutes; Stephanie 2nd; approved unanimously
- <u>Curriculum-related update</u> BALA (Big Arts in the Little Apple) event was this past Saturday at the PAC – great pieces and spectacular event; art pieces are displayed throughout the community)

Enrollment

Update – students primarily from Classical, home-school – KA numbers have declined; push to KA contacts with focus on leadership and also to current students at North – appealing to leadership opportunities and senior capstone project experience; 17 currently applied for freshman year, so total enrollment around low 84/85 (goal is 100); marketing focus on portfolio development, senior capstone project and rigorous curriculum; alumni connection/benefits they discovered firsthand critical; no marketing plan in place to follow up – shadow days critical; get follow up info from parents/students at Explore Night and All School Charter Fair (sign in); Shadow Day has follow up contact; once students are in high school, we market student to student; strategy for 8th grade is parent focus with Alumni connection

Short term - how do we get 10 students; Stephanie will make follow up calls to recent shadows' parents; August 13th is lock in for numbers; establish parent ambassador (Stephanie) and alumni ambassador (Claudia) with contact info listed on Facebook and website; determine top 3 questions from parents and students – Claudia address in a video?; panel with Alumni for shadows and currently applied students in near future?; Stephanie and Claudia will coordinate with Lori to follow up with parents/students who shadowed; sent out info regarding senior capstone project to SLP (Student Leadership Program) in district

Next Steps – bring back Showcase Night with separate presentation for parents and students with Alum presentation; marketing plan in place with Claudia in May (visually appealing and universally understandable); focus on target audience/student; visibility at events; correct marketing plan – June retreat; data driven plan with google survey; engage with other alumni
