- 1. Attendance/Guest Introduction: Lori Krueger, Patrick Lee, Gregg Syring, Julia Squier (virtually), Kevin Tubbs, Kristie Moder, Jean Pynenberg, new staff member (Leah Dreyer) stopped by to introduce herself
- 2. **Approval of August Minutes:** Gregg moved to approve August minutes; passed unanimously
- 3. Monthly Reports:
  - a. Enrollment Update/FTE (Lori/Patrick) 68 is current enrollment (19 freshmen); however, some students in alternative credit recovery programs are counted in North's count and not for FCLA misleading; should be 71; 73 was previous year's count; concerns regarding impact; new administrator replacing Ben Vogel plans to visit FCLA and observe classes, so that is positive; .5 Jean, .5 Kristie, .2 for leadership, .4 Leah (.8 overall with North assignments), Camber and Maves remain the same
  - b. Cash Flow Update (Patrick) 501c3 account remains at \$3289.55; Julia will check past stipend amount paid to Kelly Camber for internship coordination from the 501c3 account believes it was \$1000-1500; Julia made motion to pay stipend of not more than \$1500 to Kelly Camber for internship coordination; Gregg 2<sup>nd</sup>; passed unanimously; \$300-400 per pupil deposit from 2020/2021 pending yet; teachers are collecting a \$25 per student supply fee for the school year will deposit into activity account; not major purchases from E-10 accounts
  - c. Curriculum Update (Kristie/Jean) 911 art display is in the main lobby of North all students participated in this as part of foundations, personal story focus with an emphasis on project management process; book study unique to each grade includes 7 Habits, A Whole New Mind by Daniel Pink and Sherlock Holmes; new round begins today
