- a. Enrollment Update/FTE (Lori/Patrick) currently 58 no out of district numbers yet; district response was plan on 1.9; remove .1 teacher leadership, remove .1 from Jean and move PFM to 8th hour, remove .1 from Gus Maves and students take phy ed at North; 2.2 to 1.9 reduction of .3 FTE; Patrick working with Paul Hermes on schedule to accommodate our students; Kristie in touch with Al Brandt and has concerns about our charter contract of half day we don't have staff to cover 4 hour day given only 1.9 FTE; board concern is that students get the credits they need to graduate in each content area remove pfm, freshmen phy ed; eliminate students during 8th hour, maintain 5, 6 and 7 hour not ideal but students will get credits they need; plan on 1.9 FTE was from district admin level no clarity is it worth Gregg reach out directly to Mike Hernandez or what other outreach can we do school board, Greg Hartjes, other admin?
