- <u>Approval of November Minutes</u> Gregg made motion to approve August minutes; Kevin 2<sup>nd</sup>; passed unanimously
- Feeding America (Patti Habeck, President) food bank on large scale, covers 36 counties or 65% of WI one in Little Chute and Milwaukee 30 million pounds of food distributed, started 35 years ago, logistics and programing focus, volunteers do everything, mission not about serving the need but solving hunger changing attitudes, Medical College of WI study do more research, move fresh produce into community quickly, working with education not food drive focus but test new programs or ideas research focus move needle, leadership opportunities, Grant Storm farm link program, looking at "thinking" space, try new things and changing thinking prepare for next big challenge, ideas: service projects, workshop related to innovation, use in foundations and follow it up juniors with career planning and possible senior capstone project, understand the business of a non-profit and political aspect, Milwaukee facility would be great to see, Fresh Start initiative trust and forming relationships with other organization students could be part of the planning process, field trip/tour of facility, logistics and funding focus, future board meeting at Feeding America?
