- <u>Roll Call / Attendance/Guests</u> Joy Kapheim, Renee Ulman, Jennifer Dieter, Julia Squier (presided over meeting - Mary Welch, President, absent), Terry Maves, Mark Kloehn, Dayton Henderson; possibly take off the month of July since it is a slower time and school is out - discuss and vote in August.
- <u>Announcements</u> Letter sent to Barry re: scholarship, with notes regarding possible criteria. No response to date; dates look good on calendar for the upcoming school year; to add Dec 1st Career Expo, Nov 1st charter school fair; Julia will email Renee calendar.
- Approval of Minutes Motion to approve by Renee; second by Terry; passed unanimously
- <u>ACA Enrollment Report</u> status quo, some emails regarding new inquiries over the summer, open enrollment pending from district yet (end of July), more private school enrollments compared to previous years, many siblings this year too.
- <u>Budget</u> ILC symposium expense since our last budget report; Patrick will update for August meeting; is working on a new format to communicate budget.

Planning Budget/Sustainability for the next school year (Dayton/Jennifer) – substitute expense - \$2500, FTE issue - .2 is \$16,000 (1 hour all year), field trip expenses - \$1000, so approx. \$20,000 in expenses; consulting with middle school and WISN brings in approx \$2500, district buyouts related to curriculum once every 5 years (rotates with science and social studies) but not a guaranteed yearly income item, capitalize on student projects (student internship stipend?) – Terry willing to ask regarding Reboot downtown; Renee will touch base with Terry; Renee will talk with Patrick to confirm numbers regarding what we get from the district; Dayton and Jennifer have enough figures to pull something together for our retreat day in August; student fundraiser – what avenue to pursue, one less time intensive with a better outcome; suggested linking to field trips and/or supply needs (concrete examples) – Human Race still a great option but promote at start of year; golf outing donation is not always a given a yearly receipt; Julia will email Patrick budget sheet shared today

<u>Staff Report</u> – Cindy D will not be with ACA during the next school year (her focus will be with Willems Marketing – she will continue working with ACA students earning an employability skills certificate - off campus teaching); currently looking for a .2 to hire last hour of the day with a technology focus; Renee will forward job description and Patrick will post next week; 8th hour is lab time; Terry also recommended evaluating our "bench strength" – how the school should sustain itself beyond current staff members (succession plan) – retreat discussion topic? Posting....
