<u>ACA Reports</u>

Year in Review – technology emphasis utilizing Chad Behnke's expertise; worked with History Museum at the Castle, Bergstrom Glass Museum, Winagamie Golf Course, FVTC event planning, germ-resistant bacteria project with UW-Fox Valley, Valley Packaging, Leadership of the Fox Cities; 90% of juniors completed 10 out of 14 leadership traits; career based learning – ACA is model for district (leadership skills, FVTC class) - 24 students completed the Wisconsin DPI Youth Leadership Certificate, 3 Employability Skills Certificate, 4 CAN certification from FVTC, 14 students completed the Meeting and Event Management Course through FVTC including 2 teachers who now can offer the course through FVTC for transcripted credit; MAP testing stats – math improvement – response to instruction?; Bronze Award based on 2013-2014 WKCE scores, Student Achievement; ACT scores similar to North average; Student work keys testing showed great results – all junior students received awards except 1; juniors met with seniors at the end of the year to discuss senior capstone project – worked well

<u>Budget</u>

Current Budget – Patrick reviewed; will consolidate fundraising and booster; Human Race money should be deposited into the 501c3 acct; we need to itemize specific needs for school on a yearly basis

AASD Funds & ACA, Inc (501c3) - \$43,156.01 in AASD and \$2854.43 in 501c3

2014-15 Fundraising Plan and Results – need to know specific needs of school?; Marketing Alumni survey, follow-up with former students and tell their story; asking for "college and career readiness"; our value message should be specific to alumni, corporations, etc. (legacy giving focus also)

 <u>Succession Plans</u> - Job descriptions for Renee, Patrick and staff descriptions are being developed; Mr. Ropella retiring in 3 years (History and English – dual certification); How do we post or groom other teachers?; maybe offer staff development at ACA; board member, principal on interview committee – ACA "sharing" mindset needed; board offers stipend for staff development?

Introductory Article re: Growth – our mission is not to expand but focus on ACA at North (getting students college and career ready in ACA regardless of test scores, financial background – fosters collaboration, creativity); revisit business engagement roundtable; we want businesses to come to us with requests; 10th anniversary gala!; we need alumni data (How many come back to the community?); approach businesses as we need you to be involved and share opportunities in your company to get kids back in the community Staff Needs/Concerns & Board Support - Rebranding, 10 Yr. anniversary event, tracking graduates, student achievement recognition – 3 strands of career clusters doesn't really fit any longer – leadership focus; do celebration event; tracking graduates is an area that needs help; KA, parochial and home school students are drawn to ACA; suggested student business internship related to student clubs/apparel needs?; ACP (Academic Career Plan) will be mandated in 2017; entrepreneurial spirit – what is broke and how do you fix it
